How to make your Objections known to SDDC

South Derbyshire District Council have received an outline planning application for the erection of a large scale industrial/commercial estate in Willington. We believe the proposed development would decimate our village with widespread disruption caused due to significant increase in traffic in and around the location, there are also many aspects of the development that do not fall in line with SDDC's Local Plan.

Willington Parish Council asks that you, as fellow South Derbyshire District Council Parishes, support our campaign to fight this speculative proposal by objecting to the development which can be done by objecting to the planning application at SDDC's planning page <https://planning.southderbyshire.gov.uk/> or you can simply write to or email the planning department with your objection.
