The Parish council had considered this during the initial phase of consultation in September and offered no objections.

Sir Henry reported on his attendance at the last Toyota Liaison Committee which included an inspection of the Solar Power arrays which now provide some 5% of the plants power. None could be placed on the roof as they were not designed structurally to take their weight. In response to a question on the Railhead, Toyota responded by saying that the company has not instigated the process but if plans do go ahead they may take an interest.

Cllr Miles Nesbitt reported on his attendance at a meeting arranged by SDDC to provide information on Neighbourhood Planning. He summarised the process and concluded by indication the production of a Neighbourhood plan was a long, complicated and expensive process and needed approval of the District Council and the consensus of the people.
